ARTIFICIAL LEATHER





Artificial leather is imitation leather that is generally made from natural and/or synthetic fibres on which there is a PVC layer. As a result, artificial leather does not require care. In artificial leather, this PVC layer often imitates the structure of leather, meaning that in most cases it is very difficult to distinguish between artificial and real leather at first glance.

CLEANING

DEEP AND INTENSIVE CLEANING

Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
<p>HEAVIER DIRT THAT IS ALKALINE-SOLUBLE</p> <p>like protein, oil and grease or foodstuff residue e.g. coffee, red wine etc. can be removed by intensive cleaning using Maradin HC 43.</p>	Apply the cleaning solution evenly, and leave it to work for a short time.	
	Clean it with a suitable microfibre cloth or hand pad.	
	Pick up the loosened dirt, and rinse with water.	

DAILY ROUTINE CLEANING

Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
<p>ORGANIC/INORGANIC CONTAMINATION</p> <p>like protein, oil and grease or foodstuff residue e.g. coffee, red wine etc.</p> <p>Mild cleaners such as the neutral, protective Vario Clean Trendy T 560 plastics cleaner, or the ready-to-use Drizzle® Blue SP 20 spray cleaner are well-suited to daily routine cleaning.</p> <p><i>PLEASE NOTE: Always perform a material compatibility test before using the stated products!</i></p>	Apply the cleaning solution evenly, and leave it to work for a short time.

INITIAL TREATMENT

Artificial leather cannot be coated, impregnated or subject to initial treatment without impairing its appearance.
