

## CERAMIC TILES



Ceramic is a catch-all term for all products made from moulded or fired clay. A distinction is made between coarse and fine ceramic. Coarse ceramic includes various materials such as bricks, roof tiles, wall and floor tiles made from clinker, and glazed tiles. The fired clay (biscuit) is not permeable to water. For this reason, the fired material is glazed and then fired a second time. Ceramic tiles with a glaze. They are highly resistant to chemicals.

### CLEANING

#### DEEP CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Pick up loose dirt, and remove any mortar, plaster residue, and colour stains manually using a scraper.	<b>LIME DEPOSITS</b>  Cement residue in areas with high water hardness, as well as after renovations, can be removed using Buz® Contracalc G 461.	Pre-wet the floor covering (important for protecting the cement joints!), and apply the cleaning solution.	
		Deep clean using a single-disc machine and a white brush or microfibre/active fibre pad.	
		Pick up the loosened dirt using a wet vacuum cleaner, and rinse with water.	
	<b>RESIDUE FROM CARE PRODUCTS</b>  in the form of coatings and care products can be removed using Corridor® Unic Ultra S 707 or Planta® Multi Stripper P 321.	Apply the cleaning solution evenly over the floor, and leave it to work for approximately 10 to 15 minutes. <i>PLEASE NOTE: Do not allow the cleaning solution to dry.</i>	
		Deep clean the floor covering using a single-disc machine and a red pad.	
		Pick up the loosened dirt using a wet vacuum cleaner, and rinse with water.

### INTENSIVE CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
<p>Pick up loose dirt, and remove any mortar, plaster residue, and colour stains manually using a scraper.</p>	<p><b>HEAVIER DIRT THAT IS ALKALINE-SOLUBLE</b></p> <p>like protein, oil and grease or foodstuff residue e.g. coffee, red wine etc. can be removed by intensive cleaning using Erol® G 490.</p>	<p>Apply the cleaning solution evenly over the floor, and leave it to work for a short time.</p>
