


# Cleaning and care instructions

## CORK FLOOR COVERINGS



Cork is the regenerative bark of the cork oak and is harvested by hand without damaging the tree. The bark grows year on year and is stripped for the first time after 25 years. Thanks to its unique natural properties, cork is exceptionally well-suited to use in floor coverings. Cork floor coverings make spaces quiet, as they absorb noise, and their natural thermal insulation keeps rooms at an optimal temperature - added to which, they are very comfortable and easy on the joints when walking and standing. Do not use cleaners which contain acid or are strongly alkaline. Unsealed cork coverings must only be lightly moistened and wiped.

### CLEANING

#### INTENSIVE CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Pick up loose dirt and remove any mortar, plaster residue and colour stains manually using a scraper.	<b>TOUGHER, ALKALI-SOLUBLE DIRT</b> can be removed by intensive cleaning with Maradin HC 43 using a two-stage wet wiping method, or mechanically.	Apply the cleaning solution evenly over the floor, and leave it to work for a short time.	
		Clean using a single-disc machine and a red pad	
		Pick up the loosened dirt using a wet vacuum cleaner, and rinse with water	 

### PRIMING

#### CARE

Care	Treatment	Cleaning device
Heavily mechanical methods and frequent intensive cleaning can cause long-term damage to cork coverings. Cork, a natural product, becomes porous, meaning dirt can permeate its deeper layers; this dirt is then very difficult to remove with only daily routine cleaning. It is therefore recommended that you prime the surface to make the covering more resistant.	Apply up to two thin layers of Corridor® Basic S 720 pore filler/primer, depending on the absorbency, and leave each layer to dry completely. <i>PLEASE NOTE: Corridor® Basic S 720 is not dissolved during later intensive cleaning, and is therefore a permanent primer that only needs to be renewed after some years.</i>	
	Polishing is not required.

## CARE

### INITIAL TREATMENT

Care	Treatment	Cleaning device
Cork floor coverings can also be coated with Corridor® Complete S 732 dispersion on request to improve the appearance.	Apply the dispersion undiluted onto the dry, deep-cleaned/primed floor covering in two thin layers, leaving each individual layer to dry completely.	
	Polishing is not required.	

## CLEANING

### DAILY ROUTINE CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Microfibre cloths or pads must always be used in order to achieve a satisfactory cleaning result.	<b>ORGANIC/INORGANIC DIRT</b> such as protein, oil and grease or food debris, e.g. coffee, red wine, etc.  Products such as the Corridor® Daily S780, Corridor® Cibreeze S790 with odour blocker, Planta® Clean P315 or Corridor® PUR Clean S 766 are well-suited to daily routine cleaning.	Manual floor treatment
