FLOOR COVERINGS IN SUPERMARKETS



In the supermarket sector, as well as calcareous and non-calcareous artificial stone coatings, we primarily find stoneware or porcelain stoneware coatings. The latter are micro-porous, fine-rough, sometimes glossy stoneware tiles.

CLEANING

DEEP CLEANING OF CALCAREOUS ARTIFICIAL STONE COATINGS


	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Pick up loose dirt and remove any mortar, plaster residue and colour stains manually using a scraper.	LIME DEPOSITS in areas with high water hardness, as well as cement residue, can only be removed using light mechanical movement and O Tens Azid G 501.	Pre-wet the floor covering and apply the cleaning solution.	
		Deep clean using a single-disc machine and a white pad. <i>PLEASE NOTE: do not use cement residue removers!</i>	
		Pick up the loosened dirt using a wet vacuum cleaner, and rinse with water	
	RESIDUE FROM CARE PRODUCTS in the form of coatings and care products can be removed using Corridor® Unic Ultra S 707, Corridor® Power Stripper S 708 or Planta® Multi Stripper P 321.	Apply the cleaning solution evenly over the floor, and leave it to work for approximately 10 to 15 minutes. <i>PLEASE NOTE: Do not allow the cleaning solution to dry.</i>	
		Deep clean the covering using a single-disc machine and a blue pad.	
		Pick up the loosened dirt using a wet vacuum cleaner, and rinse with water.

DAILY ROUTINE CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
<p>Microfibre cloths or pads must always be used in order to achieve a satisfactory cleaning result. Red cleaning pads are also suitable.</p>	<p>ORGANIC/INORGANIC DIRT</p> <p>e.g. protein, oil and grease or food debris e.g. coffee, red wine, etc.</p>	<p>The Maradin HC 43 slightly alkaline intensive cleaner is particularly well-suited to daily routine cleaning in supermarkets.</p>	
	<p>BUILD-UP OF LIME FILM</p>	<p>Regular use of acidic, surfactant-free cleaner O Tens Azid G 501 prevents the build-up of lime film. PLEASE NOTE: Alternating use of Maradin HC 43 and O Tens Azid G 501 will provide comprehensive protection against embedded dirt. In turn, this will successfully delay the need for cost-intensive deep or intensive cleaning.</p>	

CARE

INITIAL TREATMENT

Calcareous artificial stone coatings in supermarkets should not be coated, impregnated or subjected to initial treatment, as no coating will withstand the mechanical load.
