UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE, TEXTILE



Furniture upholstery textile is mostly produced from a mix of synthetic and natural fibres. When cleaning textile upholstery, the colourfastness of the upholstery material, the upholstery filling, and the long drying time must be taken into account. A colourfastness test must be performed before using the products stated below.

CLEANING

DEEP CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Vacuum loose dirt, and remove chewing gum and colour stains manually using stain removal.	ORGANIC/INORGANIC CONTAMINATION like protein, oil and grease or foodstuff residue e.g. coffee, red wine etc.	Remove dirt using Optiflor Ex G 477 spray extraction cleaner or O Tens G 500 surfactant-free cleaner. Spray the cleaning solution evenly over the surface, and leave it to work for approximately 10 to 15 minutes.	
		Then, rinse multiple times using the spray extraction device and water.	
		Depending on the level of dirt and the depth of pile, shampooing using Optiflor® G 470 may be possible as an alternative. Using a hand sponge, create a solid foam with the product and distribute it over the surface with a soft brush or bonnet cleaning pad.	
		After drying with a brush vacuum, suck up the crystallised product with the bound dirt.

SPECIAL CLEANING

	Dirt	Treatment	Cleaning device
Vacuum loose dirt, and remove mortar, plaster residue, chewing gum and colour stains manually using stain removal.	WATER-SOLUBLE DIRT like protein, oil and grease or foodstuff residue e.g. coffee, red wine etc. can be removed by stain removal using O Tens G 500.	Soak a colourfast cloth with the cleaning solution, and loosen the stain by dabbing.	
	WATER-INSOLUBLE DIRT such as chewing gum, glue residue, wax, shoe polish or tar can be removed by stain removal using Buz® Point G 502.	Spray Buz® Point G 502 onto a colourfast cloth and loosen the stain by dabbing.
